

Special issue: Real estate Call for papers

The **Journal of Regional and Urban Economics** (JRUE-RERU) is calling for papers in English for a special issue on real estate. As a fundamental infrastructure for human activity, real estate intersects with various fields and disciplines. This special issue will primarily consider articles from regional science, management sciences, geography, economics, and urban planning. However, articles from other disciplinary perspectives or those employing a trans-disciplinary approach may be proposed if they are relevant to the journal's purpose. There are no restrictions on methodology—whether quantitative, qualitative, or comparative—or on the nature of the articles, whether theoretical or empirical.

Real estate encompasses housing (apartments, houses, serviced residences, hotels), offices (apartment buildings, skyscrapers, coworking spaces), retail (shopping centers, malls, high streets, retail parks), and logistics (warehouses, data centers, urban logistics). Other types of property may also be studied, and all scales of analysis are accepted.

The research questions may relate to real estate itself and its management (development, transactions, asset management, investment), its spatial context, or its role as a reflection or projection of contemporary social and political concerns.
